# WELCOME TO LOSTOCK HALL AND YOUR NEW HOME

## 'THE VILLAGE'

Environmentally the 'village' has seen enormous changes in the last 100 years.

Humble cottages and farms have given way to estates of semi-detached houses, a surfeit of cars speed along roads where horses and carts once ambled along dirt tracks. Life expectancy is greater, essential if time is to be found to enjoy the delights of inventive progress of radio, television, videos, fast food and travel abroad.

The hooters of 'satanic' mills have long been silent, as have the whistles of shunted locomotives, boot and shoemakers, cloggers and a beer house.

## 'Down Tardy'

Today the availability of pizza and fried chicken, demonstrates that the twenty first century has made its mark on Tardy Gate.

We use this name because it is part of our History and because many residents prefer that.

Its continuing usage will be assured so long as the inn in the centre of the village keeps its name. Tardy Gate is not a postal address. The Local authority map notes it and prints the name Lostock Hall to the south of our many railway bridges and the East Lancashire line, but there are some parishioners who still make their way 'down Tardy'

## Our Lady of Lourdes and Saint Gerard Majella RC Church



The Church of Our Lady of Lourdes and Saint Gerard Majella, known locally as Saint Gerard's, is situated in the centre of the village with its square tower reaching into the sky as a local landmark.

The Church has had an influence on the names of roads in the immediate vicinity, Saint Cuthbert's, Mercer Drive, Saint Gerrards (Note the miss-spelling) Road, Lourdes Avenue and Ampleforth Drive.

The first of our School buildings was built in 1890. Bishop Vaughan gave permission at that time to celebrate Sunday Mass in the building. The foundation stone of the present Church was laid on 7<sup>th</sup> July 1912 and the Church opened for worship on 12<sup>th</sup> October 1913.
