Contactless Machine: The diocese have engaged with a new contactless finance provider. The new machine now in the Porch will ask if you wish to Gift aid your donation, if yes you will be asked for your house number and postcode along with your Surname. You will only be asked this the first time you use a particular card. The old machine is still working during the period of transition. Don't be put off by the initial screen and the amounts show,

we would love it if everyone used these but you can select **OTHER AMOUNT** and manually enter a lower or higher figure. Please ask if you need any assistance. Thank you.

OLD COINS AND EUROS - We regularly get Euro's in the Offertory collection and still occasionally old £1 coins. We are grateful for all donations but these play havoc with the counting machine and mean extra work for our volunteers who do the banking.

Shields Centre Gardens: the gate to the gardens behind the Grotto and around the bowling green will be left unlocked so that parishioners can make use of this lovely facility. Parish Website Update - Our parish website has in recent months undergone a software refresh which has allowed us to align some of the functions that we share with St Gerard's. We now share on the home page a joint parishes diary which details all the services at the two churches. The Newsletter sign up now works and links into the same mailing list. If you would like a copy of the newsletter emailing to you each weekend you can sign up for it there. Under document/other documents there are Gift Aid and Standing Order forms as well as the form to join the 200 club and the form to enroll on a Baptism Course. Thought for the Week:

In this past week (5 Sept) we celebrated the feast of St Teresa of Kolkata ("Mother Teresa"). She was such a physically fragile woman and yet with the gift of such a strong and powerful spirit. She was convinced that God was asking her to help the person in need who was directly before her. Many people visited her in the slums of Calcutta and would often ask what was the point of helping one person in the face of so many who were suffering in poverty. She would always reply that, even if we can only help one person, that is one person less who is suffering; a little more of the presence of God alive in our world. I can often ask myself, what is the point of living a life of faith and being concerned about others when all around me seems to be self centred and focussed on personal pleasure. There are times when I give in to this temptation to follow an "unchristian" way; however, the sense of well-being, the sense of fulfilment becomes less and less. It is when I respond to the call of Christ to live His gospel, to reach out to others, to give time to prayer—these are the times when I feel most fully alive, recognising that I am living as the person God has called me to be.
