TODAY: The Sixth Sunday of Easter



There are two obvious themes to today's readings: Saint Peter summarises many of the ideas of Easter - baptism, the name of Jesus, the pouring out of the Holy Spirit; the other readings talk simply of love, both God's love for us and our love for each other. Our Gospel is taken from the

great discourse at the Last Supper, and has at its centre the New Commandment that Jesus gives his disciples - the commandment of love. This love has its origins in the love of the Father, manifested in the love shown by the Son (willing to die for his friends); we, like the disciples, are called to imitate the love we see in Jesus's life and death - not because we are servants, but because we are friends.

Ascension Thursday: Next Thursday is Ascension Day and is a Holyday of Obligation. Masses at St Mary's Brownedge are at 9.30am (with the School) and 4.30pm and at St Gerard's at 9.15am (with the School) and 7.30pm

Retreat Programme - The popular retreat programme at St Gerard's continues: The next one is on Monday 13th May 2024: — THE CLOUD OF UNKNOWING — Explore this incredible mystical text written in the 14th Century, a profound guide on prayer. The retreats start at 11:30 am through to 3 pm (with 30 minutes Lunch break (please bring a packed lunch)). The cost is £20 per person. The retreats are held in the "Shields Centre" and are led by Donna Worthington. Baptism Course Enrolment - The Next Baptism Course commences on Tuesday 14th May. Baptisms will usually take place on the first and third Sundays of the month at St Gerard's and the second and fourth Sundays of the month at St Mary's. Initial enquiries can be made by telephoning the parish secretary who will then direct you to one of the baptism team available at both churches at weekend masses. They will provide you with an enrolment form, a letter outlining the programme and a "Welcome to our parish community' card. This card, requested by the Bishop of Salford, is to be filled in whenever you attend one of six masses. It is not intended to make life difficult for parents but just to help you

familiarise yourselves and your little ones with the church, the mass and the parish community into which your child is to be baptised and welcomed. Courses will take place approximately every two months. Further details can be obtained from Fr Mark, Fr Colin, Anna the parish secretary, or anyone on the baptism team.

Choir Concert: Leeds Male Voice Choir are presenting a concert at St Mary's Brownedge on Saturday 18th May at 2pm. They are a vibrant and dynamic choir who perform regularly across the North of England. They will be performing an eclectic and uplifting mix of music fit for an early summer afternoon. Admission will be by donation and the proceeds will be shared between the parish and Caritas. Make a date in the diary for a great occasion.

CAFOD - Wills - No one watching the news or reading the weekly notices can be unaware of the many crises the world is facing at the present time and of the need for us as Christians to respond. CAFOD, with our financial support, are doing this on our behalf but as more and more crises emerge they are always trying to raise funds. Over one third of their income comes from legacies and they are asking that anyone who has not yet made a will to consider leaving a small legacy to them. There is no obligation to do so of course but they do offer a free Will-writing service. There are notices and leaflets at the back of church if anyone is interested, with contact details.

CAFOD - Sudan - Whilst Ukraine and Gaza are constantly in the news, another crisis has been emerging in Sudan where over the past year the Sudanese Government and paramilitaries have been fighting constantly. As a result, 8 million people have been made homeless and 25 million are facing starvation. Borders have been closed and humanitarian aid is proving difficult to get into the country. CAFOD, however, are on the ground and still able to support families with food packages, cash payments, and helping locals to rebuild pipelines so they can access clean water. Please pray for the Sudanese caught up in this crisis and over the next few weeks we will discuss action we can take as a linked parish, but meanwhile anyone who feels they can donate to this crisis appeal can donate on cafod.org.uk/ sudanappeal

CAFOD/SVP Joint Venture: The General Election: A UK general election is due and those standing will want our votes. We have a responsibility as Catholics, to ensure that parties commit to tackling issues such as poverty and injustice. Raising our voices and contacting parliamentary candidates as a parish community will send a strong signal to them. Many more people (including pensioners) have been dragged into the tax system by the freezing of the personal allowance. If you pay any income tax you are allowed to gift aid the equivalent amount to a charity and it means for every £1 you gift aid we gain 25 pence. 
Offertory Procession: Next Sunday 12th May 2024 9:30 am Mass: The Worcester Family.
