Today's second reading was not chosen to match the Gospel and first reading, yet it fits them remarkably well. Much of the message of Romans is reflected in this Sunday's Liturgy of the Word: the Messiah came first to Israel, the people to whom God's promises were given. But the good news could not remain with them alone. It was destined for all nations, so that every people, and indeed all creation, might welcome the Messiah and share in God's Kingdom. As the psalm proclaims: "Let all the peoples praise you, O God!"

Pilgrimage to Rome and Assisi:

This year is the 800th anniversary of the death of St Francis.: **Monday 2nd November to Sunday 8th November**. Flights from Manchester; First three nights near Rome at the English College Villa, Palazzola with a day into Rome for a General Audience with Pope Leo; Other visits either into Rome or maybe taking the opportunity to visit Subiaco or Monte Cassino— both great abbeys associated with St Benedict. The exact itinerary will be firmed up later. We will spend three nights in Assisi visiting the great shrines of St Francis and St Clare as well the tomb of the newly canonised, St Carlo Acutis. A further possibility for the itinerary is a visit to Greccio on our journey from Rome to Assisi where St Francis created the first nativity scene. The cost will be £1249 per person sharing or £1499 for a single room (limited numbers). The provisional programme is available at the back of church.
